Abstract. Font 10 pt, Normal, Justified. Abstracts of Invited lectures and Progress reports should be on one page. Contributed papers prepared for poster presentation are up to four pages. Below, detailed description of text preparation is given. All manuscripts must be submitted in English. Manuscripts should consist of the title, followed by author(s) name(s) and addresse(s), abstract, body of the text and the list of the references. Authors should not include references in Abstracts.

1. SUBTITLES

Subtitles should be 12 pt Bold, All Caps, consecutively numbered. The first line of the paragraph should be indented 1.25 cm.

Example of sub-subtitles is given here.

1.1 Sub-subtitle

Sub-subtitle is in boldface, but only first letter is capital

2. EQUATIONS

Equations should be centered and consecutively numbered. Use italic letters to denote variables (in text or in displayed equations). Please use a decimal point rather than a comma in numbers (i.e. 3.142 not 3,142).

$$\omega = N_e f(t) \alpha_1 \chi^{-c} \quad (1)$$

Please use space of 6 pt before and after Equation. Equations can be referred in text as Eq. (1) or Equation (1).

3. FIGURES

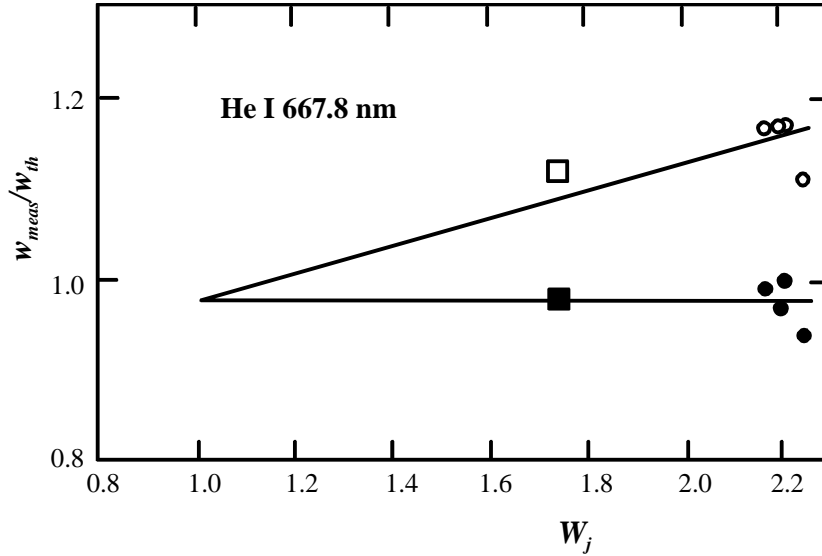


Figure 1. Figure should be centered. Figure caption 10 pt TimesNew, Normal, Justified. Before Figure caption 6 pt and 6 pt after.

Figures and graphs should be inserted in text. Please take care on size of the letters (approximately 10 pt like is in the text), symbols and line

thickness. Color drawings and color photos are not acceptable. Figures should be followed by Figure caption as it is given in the example below. Figures can be referred in the text as Fig. 1 or Figure 1. The paragraph before figure is spaced 6 pt “after”.

Tables should be inserted in the text with the table caption above and centered. Table layout is given bellow. The paragraph before table is spaced 6 pt “after”.

The full references should be listed in the numerical order of citation in the text at the end of the article. Examples:
